

# La Trobe University 2018 Melbourne Rebels tickets - competition Terms and Conditions

## Competition

1. La Trobe University (ABN 64 804 735 113) ("**University**") of Bundoora, Victoria, 3086, is conducting a competition called the "Melbourne Rebels tickets" ("**Competition**").
2. Each entry must be submitted in accordance with these Terms and Conditions. By entering the Competition, each entrant agrees to be bound by these Terms and Conditions. The University may in its discretion refuse to award any prize to any entrant who fails to comply with these Terms and Conditions.
3. Entries for the Competition will be accepted until 11:59pm (AEST), Sunday 24 June, 2018 ("**Competition Period**"). Any entry received after the expiry of the Competition Period will be deemed invalid and ineligible to win a prize. No responsibility is accepted for late, lost, delayed or misdirected entries.

## Eligibility

4. The Competition is open to all Undergraduate and Postgraduate students of the University from all campuses.

## Entry

5. Entry into the Competition is free.
6. You are entered into the competition if you send your personal details by 11:59pm (AEST), Sunday 24 June, 2018.
7. To enter the Competition, an entrant must:
8. Send their personal details by 11:59pm (AEST), Sunday 24 June 2018
9. Each entrant represents and warrants in relation to their entry that:
  - a. if below 18 years of age, they have the permission of their parent or guardian to enter the Competition
  - b. any details provided with the entry are true and accurate;
  - c. the entrant will comply with these Terms and Conditions;
  - d. the entrant has not breached any person's privacy rights, intellectual property rights or any other laws in registering for the Competition; and
  - e. the entrant will indemnify the University against any loss or damage resulting from any breach of the warranties in this clause 9.
10. Each entrant agrees to be contacted by the University for the purpose of accepting any prize for the Competition.
11. Each entrant consents to his or her name and any personal information that the entrant has provided in the course of the Competition to be disclosed, used, reproduced, communicated and published in the University's publications or in a third party's publication authorised by the University in any format for the purposes of the Competition or for any advertising or marketing purposes to be produced by the University or a third party on behalf of the University. ### **Judging and Prizes**

13. Entrants who have validly sent in their personal details will go into a random draw to receive a prize ("**Prize Winners**").
14. In total there are 5 prizes to be won:

15. The Prize Winners will be notified via phone by 5:00pm, Monday 25 June, 2018 with instructions for collecting their prizes by receiving them in the mail or in person by collecting them from an agreed location.
16. The decision of the University regarding the Prize Winner is final and will be binding on each person who enters the Competition. No correspondence or communications will be entered into.
17. The University may refuse to award a prize, or seek its recovery, in the event of the relevant entrant's fraud, dishonesty, or non-entitlement under, or breach of, these Terms and Conditions.

If there is any event that prevents or hinders the University's conduct of the Competition or the University's ability to deliver the prize to the Prize Winner of the Competition, the University may, in its discretion, cancel the Competition or select another winner. The University may also recommence the Competition at another time under the same conditions.
